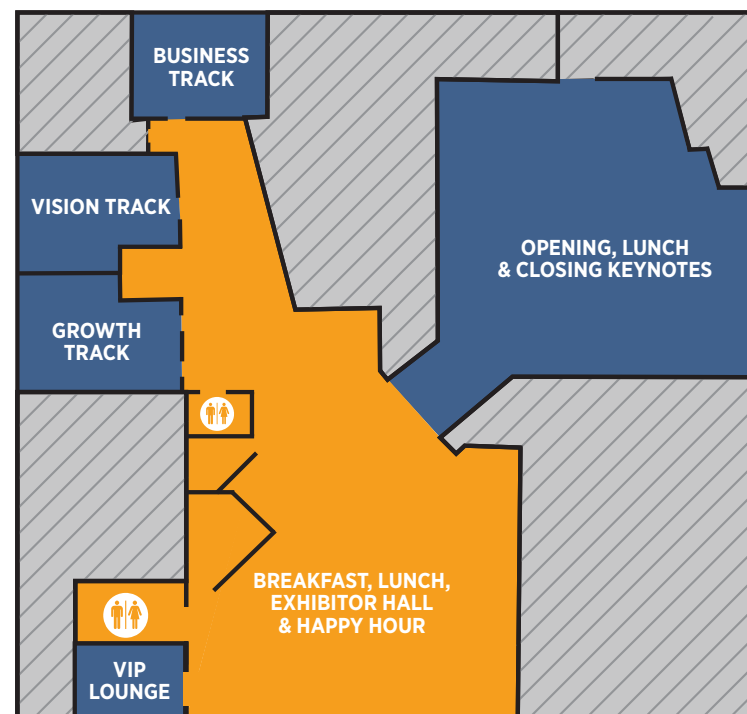
### SUMMER SANDERS OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALIST
